香港民意研究所之香港民意研究計劃(香港民研)將於<u>明日(12月1日)下午</u>舉行發佈會,發放最新行政長官及特區政府民望、最新一輪「我們香港人意見群組調查」和「疫後復聚指數」。

香港民研於五月底宣佈重整「我們香港人」計劃後,每星期透過研究所的Facebook專 頁邀請市民就社會時事議題提供意見題目,進行網上投票,並把票數最高的一至多條 題目納入「香港民研意見群組」調查,然後公佈結果。上星期開始進行的是第二十六 輪調查,題目為:「教育局以教學出現嚴重錯誤為原因取消一名可立小學教師的教師註 冊。你有多支持或反對這個決定?」截至今天上午9時半,已經有近三千人次參與。由 於我們上星期四要發表施政報告的即時調查結果,所以是次「我們香港人」的結果順 延至明日(12月1日)下午才公佈,敬請留意。

HKPOP will release tomorrow the popularities of CE and SAR Government, our "We Hongkongers Survey" on a teacher from Ho Lap Primary School being deregistered along with the "Post-Epidemic Gathering Resumption Index"

The Hong Kong Public Opinion Program (HKPOP) under the Hong Kong Public Opinion Research Institute (HKPORI) will hold a press conference tomorrow (December 1) afternoon to release the latest popularities of CE and SAR Government, results of the latest "We Hongkongers Panel Survey" along with the "Post-Epidemic Gathering Resumption Index".

HKPOP has re-launched its "We Hongkongers" Initiative in late May. Every week we invite Hong Kong people to suggest current affairs survey questions to us via our Facebook page, then cast their votes online to select the question(s) for our "We Hongkongers Panel Survey", and then release the results. The survey started last week is the twenty-sixth round. The survey question is "The Education Bureau deregistered a teacher from Ho Lap Primary School for having made serious mistakes in his teaching. How much do you support or oppose this decision?" Up to 9:30 am today, around 3,000 submissions have been received. As we had to release the Policy Address Instant Poll findings last Thursday, the announcement of this "We Hongkongers" survey has been postponed to **tomorrow** (December 1) afternoon. Please stay tuned.
