



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

Survey method	Online survey	
Target population	Hong Kong residents aged 18+	
Total sample size	3,637	
Response rate	4.4%	
Sampling error	Sampling error of percentages at +/-1.6% at 95% confidence level	
Weighting method	Rim-weighted according to 1) gender-age distribution, educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution of Hong Kong population from Census and Statistics Department; 2) appraisal of political condition and political inclination distribution from regular telephone tracking surveys.

• Question: Q3 How much influence do you think the opinions of the following groups have had on the content of the Budget?







• Question: Q5 Overall, how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the Budget this year?




Published figures included random telephone samples, and online and telephone samples from "Hong Kong People Representative Panel", while the figures calculated by new method first excluded all random telephone samples and then data from the online samples from "Hong Kong People Representative Panel" and "Hong Kong People Volunteer Panel" were adjusted by the modified weighting method.




• Question: Q8 If you had the right to vote on the reappointment or dismissal of Paul Chan as the Financial Secretary tomorrow, how would you vote?


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• Question: Q9 In your view, who are the main beneficiaries of the Budget?
