| Weighting method | Rim-weighted according to 1) gender-age distribution, educational attainment <br> (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution <br> of Hong Kong population from Census and Statistics Department; 2) <br> appraisal of political condition and political inclination distribution from <br> regular telephone tracking surveys. |
