- Date of survey: 1-8/6/2023
- Survey method: Random telephone survey conducted by real interviewers
- Target population: Cantonese-speaking Hong Kong residents aged 18 or above
- Sample size: 1,005 (including 505 landline and 500 mobile samples)
- Effective response rate: 61.9%
- Sampling error: Sampling error of percentages not more than +/-4%, that of net values not more than +/-8% and that of ratings not more than +/-2.1 at 95% conf. level
- Weighting method: Rim-weighted according to figures provided by the Census and Statistics Department. The gender-age distribution of the Hong Kong population came from "Mid-year population for 2022", while the educational attainment (highest level attended) distribution and economic activity status distribution came from "Women and Men in Hong Kong Key Statistics (2022 Edition)".



• The latest popularity rating of CE John Lee is 51.5 marks. Among all respondents, 16% gave him 0 mark. His approval rate is 44%, disapproval rate 45%, giving a net popularity of negative 1 percentage point. Both his rating and net popularity have decreased significantly compared to a month ago and registered record lows since he took office. It is also the first time his net popularity as CE goes negative.

• As for the SAR Government, its latest satisfaction rate is 44%, whereas dissatisfaction rate stands at 42%, thus the net satisfaction is positive 2 percentage points, which has significantly decreased by 16 percentage points compared to a month ago. The mean score is 2.9, meaning close to "half-half" in general.
