1. Please join the Zoom meeting before the event starts by clicking on this weblink: [www.pori.hk/zoom\\_pc](http://www.pori.hk/zoom_pc); Meeting ID: 929 2599 6764; Passcode: 199935; or by scanning the QR Code on the right.
2. Please name your account according to your organisation, otherwise you may be refused admission.
3. Wait patiently for the host to admit you into the Zoom Meeting Room.
4. During the Q&A session, we suggest you first submit your question in writing to the host in the Zoom Chat Room. In case of technical problem, your question may be read out by the moderator.
5. The host will then give you signal when it is almost your turn to ask your question.
6. Please then unmute your Zoom session microphone to ask your question; in case technical problems creep in, the moderator will read the question for you.
7. No foul language or personal attack is allowed; the host or the moderator may sharp cut the conversation when this happens.
